About the Room and Furniture Pages

Pages 18 through 27 of the Playbook are room backdrops and furniture. The living room, dining room and kitchen are in color, while the bedroom is black-and-white.

I intend someday to digitally color the bedroom, as well as the black-and-white costume pages, but the colored versions are not yet available.

The easiest way to make the backdrops stand up is to clip the backs of two rooms together near the base with small clamps.



Most of the furniture is printed on double-sided pages. In some cases the front and back sides do not perfectly align in the originals; I have taken the liberty of making them match up better.

The best way to assemble the furniture is probably to print the front and back pages on separate pieces of card stock, and then paste the two sides together before cutting. (Tiny pin pricks made just outside the outlines of the pieces at matching places on both sheets can aid in precise alignment.) An alternative is to put the same sheet of cardstock through your printer twice to print double-sided, but the alignment may not be as good. Using two pieces of cardstock will also make your furniture pieces sturdier.
